HOW DOES IT WORK?

The CHUNDER in the park karting series are held at Buckmore Park International Kart Circuit, Chatham in Kent (www.buckmore.co.uk), racing their RX7 Sports karts. As a non title, non championship FUN event, it is open to anyone over 16 years old, from professionals to novices.

An October running means the race starts in daylight but as darkness descends it will conclude under the Buckmore floodlights making for a dramatic setting when the chequered flag is lowered for the winner.

Rules are quite simple and are based around your safety and others at the track, this includes drivers either under the influence or suspected of being under the influence of drink or drugs being excluded from the race. All drivers will be given a safety briefing before the start of the event and a practice/qualifying session.

The race is an endurance, with a maximum of 35 teams out on the track at any time, comprising teams consisting of 4 drivers minimum and 6 drivers maximum. The object is quite simply to get in more laps than the other teams. Typically a fast team will complete in the region of 190 laps. The race is for three hours, with all teams having to make 11 driver changes to balance the teams with 4 drivers and those with more drivers..

As the event is for charity there will be ample opportunities to raise the final donation for the event, and even an opportunity for all the teams to buy their way to the front with a **bid for pole** (see below) – always a good place to be when there are 34 other karts trying to get around the first corner.

To conclude the day we hold a raffle and auction, again with all the proceeds going to Rainbow Trust Some of the items we have had in previous events include; Computers, F1 sweatshirts, Flight Simulator experience, Power Shower, Pressure Washer, Toolkits, Weekend Breaks and lots more. In the words of one of the staff at Buckmore *'you always manage to get some bloody good prizes!'*

The timetable for the event is as follows

14:00 – 15:00 hrs	Arrival & Registration Do the paperwork stuff & get to meet your opponents.
15:15 – 16:00 hrs	Drivers Briefing the rules bit of the day where the adrenalin starts to pump
16:00 – 16:45 hrs	Timed Practice GO FOR IT ! Get to "be one" with the kart & the circuit! Or find where you can spin most gracefully and the last chance to buy your way up the grid
16:45 – 19:45	CHUNDER 9 GO FOR IT FOR REAL THIS TIME This is when all the planning, practice and fortune come into play Unless it rains in which case it's interesting 😊
20:00 – 20:15	Presentation of Trophies to the lucky few
20:15	CHARITY AUCTION & RAFFLE This is the important bit where we help the charity that we are all here for and buy as much as our other halves will let us get away with.
